

# eGauge date formats

There are two common date formats currently in use: dd/mm/yyyy and mm/dd/yyyy. The date format shown in the eGauge interface will default to one of these two options.

Since [firmware version 2.14](#), the date format used by the eGauge is dependent on the language requested by the browser. Browsers requesting en\_US (US English) will see mm/dd/yyyy formatting, while all other English language options should show dd/mm/yyyy. Other date and time formats are displayed if the language selection is supported by the eGauge.

Devices on older firmware versions (prior to 2.14) will always display dd/mm/yyyy, regardless of the language request sent by the browser.
